Sir/Madam,

I write as Chairperson of Fintry Community Council having attempted to register our opinion online via your consultation page (submitted under my name, Cicely Roy). The questions didn't really suit and some were of no relevance and I am not sure whether the submission was successful. Being keen to take every opportunity to get our message to you I am therefore using the suggestion to email to the address suggested.

Fintry has acknowledged problems with infiltration into the sewerage system and Scottish Water have proposed limited action to improve matters. However, we feel that even this partial remedial action has not been given the priority it deserves, particularly in view of the possibility of housing development under the Local Development Plan currently being approved. The suggestion that removing some infiltration would mean an equivalent amount of sewage from more houses could be accommodated is invalid when the quantities cannot be measured and the timing of action is so uncertain.
