

Fintry Common Good Fund - Explanatory Notes

The Fintry Development Trust (FDT) has agreed to give a grant to the Fintry Community Council which can be used to benefit groups within the Fintry Community Council area as defined by Stirling Council. The money is provided from the net earnings FDT receives under its profit sharing agreement with Earlsburn Wind Energy Limited for the turbine at Earlsburn Windfarm.

The grant will be made approximately every 6 months and the amount will vary subject to the earnings made by FDT for that period.

Who can apply for the fund?

Any group of individuals (official or unofficial) resident within the Fintry Community Council area as defined by Stirling Council.

What type of activities could receive funding?

The FCC will consider any application.

Projects unlikely to be approved are those that:

Promote the views of specific political or religious groups

Are already funded by the public sector

Are against the interests of energy conservation, energy efficiency or renewable energy

Are against the interests of FDT

How can we apply to the Common Good Fund?

Applications can only be made using the official application form which is available either from the FCC website or in hard copy at the Fintry Community Council Post Box in the Fintry Sports Centre.
